

SOUTHEAST IOWA ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE SCHOOLS AND JUNIOR HIGHS

Burlington:

James Madison FB is played at ***James Madison***. VB, BB, WR, are played at ***James Madison***. TR is held at the ***High School***. XC is held at Flint Hills Golf Course.

Aldo Leopold FB is played at the ***Aldo Leopold***. VB, BB, and WR are played at ***Aldo Leopold***. TR is held at the ***High School***.

*There are times when they may play football at Bracewell Stadium and basketball at Clark Fieldhouse. That depends on the other activities they have taking place in their school system on those dates.

Fairfield:

FB and TR are held at the ***High School Football Field***. VB, BB, and WR are held at the ***Middle School***. XC is held at Waterworks Park.

Fort Madison:

FB and TR are held at the ***High School Football Field***. VB, BB, and WR are held at the ***Middle School***. XC is held at Rodeo Park.

Keokuk:

FB and TR are held at the ***High School Football Field***. VB, BB, and WR are held at the ***Middle School***. XC is held at the ***Hawthorne Elementary/SCC complex***.

Mount Pleasant:

FB and TR are held at the ***High School Football Field***. VB, BB, and WR are held at the ***Middle School***.

Ottumwa:

FB and TR are held at ***Schaeffer Stadium***. VB and BB are held at ***Evans Middle School or Walsh***. WR is held at ***Evans Middle School***.

Washington:

FB and TR are held at the ***High School Football Field***. VB, BB, and WR are held at the ***Junior High School***. XC is held at ***Sunset Park and Marr Park at Ainsworth***.

DIRECTIONS TO ATHLETIC FACILITIES

(These maps and directions are provided to assist you in finding the playing sites at each of the towns in our conference. Should there be any mistakes or better routes to the sites, please forward that information to Corey St. John, at Keokuk Middle School.

BURLINGTON:

(1) BURLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL/HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL FIELD:

As you come up 61, you will see Burlington Notre Dame High School on your right. After you pass Notre Dame you will come to Division Street and you should turn right onto Division. Those coming from the north need to turn left onto Division. As you travel down Division you will see Burlington High School on your right. When you come to Terrace Drive, you turn right onto Terrace Drive. This street will take you around Burlington High School and you can get to the parking lot off this street.

(2) BRACEWELL STADIUM:

As you come up 61, you will see Burlington Notre Dame High School on your right. After you pass Notre Dame you will come to Division Street and you should turn right onto Division. Those coming from the north need to turn left onto Division. As you travel down Division you will see Burlington High School on your right. You need to continue along Division heading towards downtown Burlington. When you get to Central Avenue you need to turn left onto Central and travel approximately 2-3 blocks. Should you miss your turn on Central, the next two streets are 10th and 9th which also lead to Bracewell Stadium.

(2) CLARK FIELDHOUSE:

As you come up 61, you will see Burlington Notre Dame High School on your right. After you pass Notre Dame you will come to Division Street and you should turn right onto Division. Those coming from the north need to turn left onto Division. As you travel down Division you will see Burlington High School on your right. You need to continue along Division heading towards downtown Burlington. When you get to Central Avenue you need to turn left onto Central and travel approximately 2-3 blocks. Should you miss your turn on Central, the next two streets are 10th and 9th which also lead to Bracewell Stadium. Clark Fieldhouse is located at Central and Market.

(3A) JAMES MADISON MIDDLE SCHOOL (old building):

As you come up 61, you want to take the old highway into town. This is located on the "bottoms" where you begin to take the big curve to the left and up the hill. You turn off the highway to the right and there is usually construction equipment etc. sitting off to the right of the highway. There is a sign that indicates the exit is to the regional airport and the street should be called Summer. You follow the old highway as it goes parallel to the airport. You can turn right on Parkway Drive, Park Avenue, or Sunset Avenue as all three should take you to Madison Avenue. When you reach Madison off the first two streets you would have to take a left. When you reach Madison off the third street you should be right at James Madison Middle School. You want to look for Madison Avenue coming on out towards Highway 61 as you might be able to get to it earlier than driving down Summer Street.

Should you already be in Burlington and you need to get to James Madison Middle School you need to the last lighted intersection and turn left onto Mason Road. This road will connect to Harrison so continue on Harrison east until you come to Madison. Turn right onto Madison and go about 2-3 blocks with James Madison being on your left.

(3B) JAMES MADISON MIDDLE SCHOOL (new building):

As you come up 61 you will see James Madison off to your right as you come to the first major intersection. If you are in Burlington then take 61 (Roosevelt) south until you come to the last major intersection in town (McDonalds) then turn left.

(4) ALDO LEOPOLD MIDDLE SCHOOL:

To get to Aldo Leopold you need to turn right off Highway 61 onto Sunnyside, if you are traveling north, and go approximately 1/2 mile. You would take a left turn onto Sunnyside if you were driving south on Highway 61.

(5) FLINT HILLS GOLF COURSE:

Follow Highway 61 north until you come to Upper Flint Road. You will believe you have completely left Burlington. Turn right onto Upper Flint Road and travel until you come to County Road X60. Turn left onto X60 and follow it to Golf Course Road. Turn right onto Golf Course Road and Flint Hills Golf Course will be located on the left side of the road.

FAIRFIELD:

(1) FAIRFIELD HIGH SCHOOL: (High School Football Field)

As you travel into town on Highway 34, you turn right onto Forest Drive then make an immediate left onto Broadway. The high school runs parallel only a block or two north of Highway 34. Those coming from the east would take make a left onto Forest Drive.

As you travel into town on Highway 1, you go to the intersection with Highway 34. You turn right onto 34 and drive east to Avenue D. You turn left onto Avenue D and then make an immediate right onto Broadway. The high school runs parallel only a block or two north of Highway 34. Those coming down on Highway 1 would turn left onto Highway 34 and then make a left turn on Avenue D.

(2) FAIRFIELD MIDDLE SCHOOL:

As you travel into town on Highway 34 you should remain on the 4-lane until you come to the hospital/Highway 1 exit. You will pass the hospital on your left, turn left onto Fillmore Street. Should you miss Fillmore you can turn left onto Harrison Street then left again when you reach 4th Street.

As you travel into town on Highway 1 you will pass the hospital on your left, turn left onto Fillmore Street. Should you miss Fillmore you can turn left onto Harrison Street then left again when you reach 4th Street. Those coming down on Highway 1 would simply continue traveling south to Fillmore.

(3) WATERWORKS PARK:

As you travel into town on Highway 34, you travel through town on 34 to B Street. You turn right onto B Street and drive north to Waterworks Park. Those coming from the east would take a left on B Street.

As you travel into town on Highway 1, turn right after coming into town onto Burlington (Highway 34). Then left when you reach B Street and drive north to Waterworks Park. Those coming down on Highway 1 would take a left on Stone Street.

(4) DEXTER COMPLEX:

As you travel into town on Highway 34, you travel through town on 34 to B Street. You turn right onto B Street and drive north to Grimes Street where you take a left and continue until you see the Dexter Complex. Those coming from the east would take a left on 9th Street.

As you travel into town on Highway 1, continue across Burlington (Highway 34). Then turn left when you reach Grimes Street and continue until you see the Dexter Complex. Those coming down on Highway 1 would take a right on Grimes Street.

MOUNT PLEASANT:

(1) MOUNT PLEASANT HIGH SCHOOL:

As you come up 218, turn off on the first Mount Pleasant exit. Turn left back over the 4-lane and go to old Highway 218. Turn right onto old 218 and the high school will be on your right as you travel north. Those coming south on 218 would take the exit into town on old 218 and continue through the Highway 34 intersection until you see the high school on your left. Those coming from the east on Highway 34 would take a left at the intersection of Highway 34 and Old Highway 218 (Grand Ave) while those coming from the west would take a right at that intersection.

(2) FOOTBALL FIELD:(High School field named MapleLeaf Field)

As you come up 218, follow the directions as you would above for the middle school until you get to the intersection of Old Highway 218 and Highway 34. When you get to this intersection you need to turn right onto Old Highway 218 and travel north. You are looking for MapleLeaf Drive which is the intersection at McDonalds. Turn left onto Maple Leaf and follow it west until you reach Carol Avenue. The field should be on the north side of the street. Those who come in from the west would turn left at the Old Highway 218 and Highway 34 intersection. Those coming in from the north would exit the 4-lane by-pass onto Old Highway 218 and turn right when you get to McDonalds.

(3) MOUNT PLEASANT MIDDLE SCHOOL:

As you come up 218, turn off on the Highway 34 exit. Turn left back under the 4-lane and go west until you reach the 4-way stop with Highway 34 and Old Highway 218. Continue straight on Highway 34 past Hardees which will be on your right. Turn right when you get to Adams Street. Travel north on Adams and the middle school should be just as you cross Henry Street. Those coming in from the west on Highway 34 would turn left onto Adams Street.

(4) IOWA WESLEYAN COLLEGE:

As you come up 218, follow the directions as you would above for the football field. As you travel west on MapleLeaf Drive you simply continue past the football field and you will be on the campus.

(5) EAST LAKE PARK:

As you come up 218 you take the first exit from the by-pass. When you get to the stop sign you take a right and go east until you come to the park. Those coming from the north would take the last exit from the by-pass and turn to the left at the stop sign and go east until you come to the park. Those coming in from highway 34 should be able to turn south off 34, east of Mount Pleasant, and get to the park.

FORT MADISON:

(1) FORT MADISON HIGH SCHOOL:

As you travel north on Highway 61 you can turn left onto 20th Street and continue until you get to Avenue B. Those coming in from the north would turn right onto 20th Street.

(1) FOOTBALL FIELD:(High School field)

As you travel north on Highway 61 you can turn left onto 20th Street and continue until you get to Avenue B. Those coming in from the north would turn right onto 20th Street. The football field is next to the high school.

(2) FORT MADISON MIDDLE SCHOOL:

As you travel north on Highway 61 you can turn left onto 18th Street and continue until you get to Avenue G. Those coming from the north would turn right onto 18th Street.

(3) RODEO PARK:

As you travel north on Highway 61 you can turn left onto 18th Street and continue until you get to Avenue E. Turn right onto Avenue E and go to 15th Street where you would turn left. This will take you out to the park. Those coming in from the north should turn right onto Avenue E as you come down the hill into town. You then would take a right onto 15th Street.

WASHINGTON:

(1) WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL:

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can turn left onto Highway 78 and follow it to Waylon. You will come to an intersection in Waylon that is County Road 55. Turn right on 55 and that highway will take you into Washington. You will enter Washington on South Iowa Ave and when you get to Highway 92 (stop light) turn right onto the highway until you get to Jefferson Street. You turn left on Jefferson which begins the one-way streets around the high school.

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can continue up to Highway 92. Exit and turn left onto Highway 92 which will take you through Ainsworth and into Washington. Highway 92 is called Washington Street in this part of town. Turn left onto 4th Street then right on Madison Street.

(2) WASHINGTON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL:

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can turn left onto Highway 78 and follow it to Waylon. You will come to an intersection in Waylon that is County Road 55. Turn right on 55 and that highway will take you into Washington. You will enter Washington on South Iowa Ave and when you get to Sitler Drive you turn left and follow it to the Junior High Building. If you miss this street you can turn left onto Highway 92 and you will see the Junior High Building off to your left

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can continue up to Highway 92. Exit and turn left onto Highway 92 which will take you through Ainsworth and into Washington. Remain on Highway 92 until you come to South Ave B. Turn left onto South Ave. B.

(3) FOOTBALL FIELD:(High School field)

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can turn left onto Highway 78 and follow it to Waylon. You will come to an intersection in Waylon that is County Road 55. Turn right on 55 and that highway will take you into Washington. You will enter Washington on South Iowa Ave and when you get to the stop sign intersection with Van Buren you turn right and follow that to the football field.

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can continue up to Highway 92. Exit and turn left onto Highway 92 which will take you through Ainsworth and into Washington. Highway 92 is called Washington Street in this part of town. Turn left onto S. 9th Street and follow it to Van Buren Street.

(4) SUNSET PARK:

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can turn left onto Highway 78 and follow it to Waylon. You will come to an intersection in Waylon that is County Road 55. Turn right on 55 and that highway will take you into Washington. You will enter Washington on South Iowa Ave and when you get to the intersection with Highway 92, take a left onto Highway 92. Remain on 92 until you see the park on your right.

As you travel north on Highway 218 you can continue up to Highway 92. Exit and turn left onto Highway 92 which will take you through Ainsworth and into Washington. Highway 92 is called Washington Street in this part of town. Continue on this street until you go through town and eventually you will see the park on your right. You can enter by turning right on F Avenue or right at the Washington Aquatic Center.

MARR PARK IS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF HIGHWAY 92 ABOUT ONE MILE WEST OF AINSWORTH.

OTTUMWA:

(1) OTTUMWA HIGH SCHOOL:

As you come into Ottumwa on Highway 34 you want to follow the directions for getting to the high school football field. When you get to the Iowa Avenue/4th Street intersection located at the practice football field you need to take a left onto 4th street. Continue on 4th Street past the main entrance to the football field and past Anne G. Wilson Elementary School. You will come up behind Ottumwa High School where you will find parking lots and the entrance to the gym on the back side of the building.

(2) FOOTBALL FIELD:(High School field named Schaeffer Stadium)

As you come into Ottumwa on Highway 34 you want to take the first Ottumwa exit. Turn left and go over the four lane until you come to an intersection with stop lights. Turn right at this intersection and as you continue straight this becomes Main Street and you go to the first intersection with a stop light, which is Iowa Avenue. You take a right onto Iowa Avenue and go up the hill, continuing until you come to a 4-way stop intersection which is 4th street. This intersection is at the corner of the practice football field. You should go one more block past the practice field then take a left which will take you down to the visitor side of the football field and the parking lot.

(3) WALSH:

As you come into Ottumwa on Highway 34 you want to follow the directions above for going to Evans Middle School. When you get to the large intersection past Beach Ottumwa you need to turn right instead of left. You go back over the Des Moines River and you stay on this highway as it goes past the fire station on your left. Continue on this highway until you see Hy-Vee on your right. You will turn right at the intersection immediately past Hy-Vee. Once you turn right, you will make an immediate left turn onto Clearview which will take you behind the bank/gas station/car wash. You will turn right off Clearview onto McCarroll Drive which takes you straight into the Walsh parking lot.

(4) FOOTBALL FIELD:(Middle School field located at Evans Middle School)

See the directions to Evans Middle School as this field is directly behind the middle school building.

(4) EVANS MIDDLE SCHOOL:

As you come into Ottumwa on Highway 34 you want to take the first Ottumwa exit. Turn left and go over the four lane until you come to an intersection with stop lights. Continue straight through that intersection which will take you past the Cargill meatpacking plant and across the Des Moines River. You want to continue in the right lane as the highway will take you towards town. You will see John Deere on your left, baseball fields and the Ottumwa Events Center on your right. You will want to move to the left lane prior to the point where you can see Beach Ottumwa on your right and the baseball fields/tennis courts on your left because you need to take a left turn at the large intersection immediately past these. When you turn left at the intersection, this road will take you through Ottumwa Park and you will approach an intersection with stop lights. You need to continue straight through this intersection so that Wendy's is

on your right and Kentucky Fried Chicken is on your left. Continue straight on this street past the BP station and in about 4 blocks you will come to a 4-way stop intersection at Evans Middle School. Turn right at this intersection as the parking lot is just past the building off this street.

(5) INDIAN HILLS COMMUNITY COLLEGE:

As you come into Ottumwa on Highway 34 you want to take the third Ottumwa exit which should have a sign indicating it is the exit for Indian Hills Community College. You take a left turn off that exit, go back over the 4-lane and follow that street to the Indian Hills College entrance which will be on your right.

KEOKUK:

(1) KEOKUK HIGH SCHOOL:

As you come into Keokuk from the north, you turn left at the first intersection (Carbide / Plank). There is a Casey's on your right at this intersection. You follow Plank Road past Tolmie Park, Keokuk Cardinal Stritch School, and the swimming pool. You will continue through the first 4-way stop intersection to the second 4-way stop intersection. The high school is to your left and the high school parking lot is at this intersection. Turn left, go one block, then turn right.

(2) FOOTBALL STADIUM:

The stadium is located behind the high school and middle school building. All visitors need to park in the middle school parking lot and enter the stadium from the middle school parking lot.

(3) KEOKUK MIDDLE SCHOOL:

As you come into Keokuk from the north, you turn left at the first intersection (Carbide / Plank). There is a Caseys on your right at this intersection. You follow Plank Road past Tolmie Park, Keokuk Cardinal Stritch School, and the swimming pool. You will continue through the first 4-way stop intersection to the second 4-way stop intersection. The high school is to your left and the high school parking lot is at this intersection. Turn left and continue through the 4-way stop intersection. As you pass the high school you will see the middle school on your right. Go past the middle school and turn immediately turn right onto 20th and you will see the parking lot behind the middle school. Entrance to the middle school is the entrance closest to the high school building. Entrance to the football field is at the Alternative School building at the parking lot.

(4) HAWTHORNE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL:

As you come into Keokuk from the north, you turn left at the first intersection (Carbide / Plank). There is a Caseys on your right at this intersection. You follow Plank Road a short distance then turn left onto Messenger, which is just around the turn. The Super 8 Motel will be on your right and there is a large electrical transformer station where you make your turn. Follow Messenger past SCC and you will see Hawthorne off to your right. Turn right onto Decatur.
